



Welcome to the Graves Gallery



The Graves Gallery is on the third floor of the Central Library in Sheffield.

It is free to enter, and you will not need a ticket.



This is the main entrance to the library.

It may look like this when you visit.

There are steps up to the entrance of the library. There are a lot stairs to reach the gallery, or you can use the lift.

There is step free access and a larger lift at the entrance on Arundel Gate.



This is the way in from Arundel Gate. To access the lift and accessible toilet you need to ring the bell and wait for a member of the library staff to let you in. They will help you get to the gallery.



If you're entering through the main entrance you can choose the lift or stairs to find the gallery. The Graves Gallery is on the top floor of the library.



There are toilets as you enter the gallery.



This is the welcome desk and shop.

A member of staff will greet you here and answer any questions. They wear a uniform like this.



There are seven rooms with lots of different artworks. Some will change regularly. It might look different when you visit.

You are not allowed to touch the art, but you can ask questions if you would like to find out more about it. There will be friendly staff who can help.
